

## SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR VETERAN FAMILIES GRANT

Treasure Coast Homeless Services Council has been awarded a Veterans Families grant. This grant will provide supportive services to very—low-income Veterans living in or transitioning to permanent housing.

Eligible Veterans and families will be provided with supportive services in the form of rental assistance, information /referrals, assistance in obtaining VA and other benefits or other assistance as needed.

## **Eligible Recipients:**

- 1. Household MUST contain a Veteran that has served in the Military and MUST have other than dishonorable discharge.
- 2. Household MUST be at or below 50% of the Area Median Income (AMI– See chart below)
- 3. Household MUST be **HOMELESS** or at **RISK of becoming homeless** AND have no resources or support (family, friends, faith based or other networks) immediately available to prevent them from becoming literally homeless.

## To be eligible for services, households must have a gross income of less than the following:
