



## SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR VETERAN FAMILIES GRANT

Treasure Coast Homeless Services Council has been awarded a Veterans Families grant. This grant will provide **supportive services to very– low-income Veterans living in or transitioning to permanent housing.**

Eligible Veterans and families will be provided with supportive services in the form of rental assistance, information /referrals, assistance in obtaining VA and other benefits or other assistance as needed.

### Eligible Recipients:

1. Household **MUST** contain a Veteran that has served in the Military and **MUST** have other than dishonorable discharge.
2. Household **MUST** be at or below 50% of the Area Median Income (AMI– See chart below)
3. Household **MUST** be **HOMELESS** or at **RISK of becoming homeless** AND have no resources or support (family, friends, faith based or other networks) immediately available to prevent them from becoming literally homeless.

**To be eligible for services, households must have a gross income of less than the following:**
